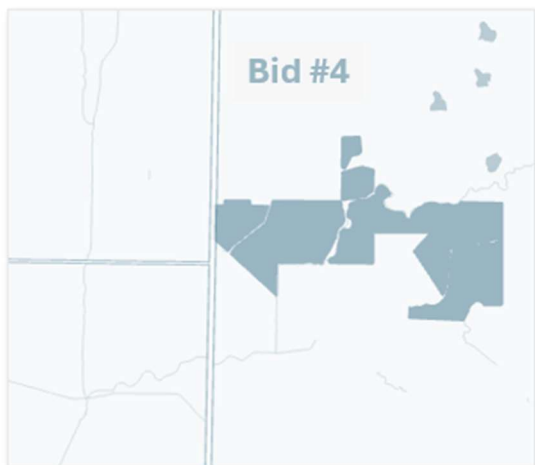
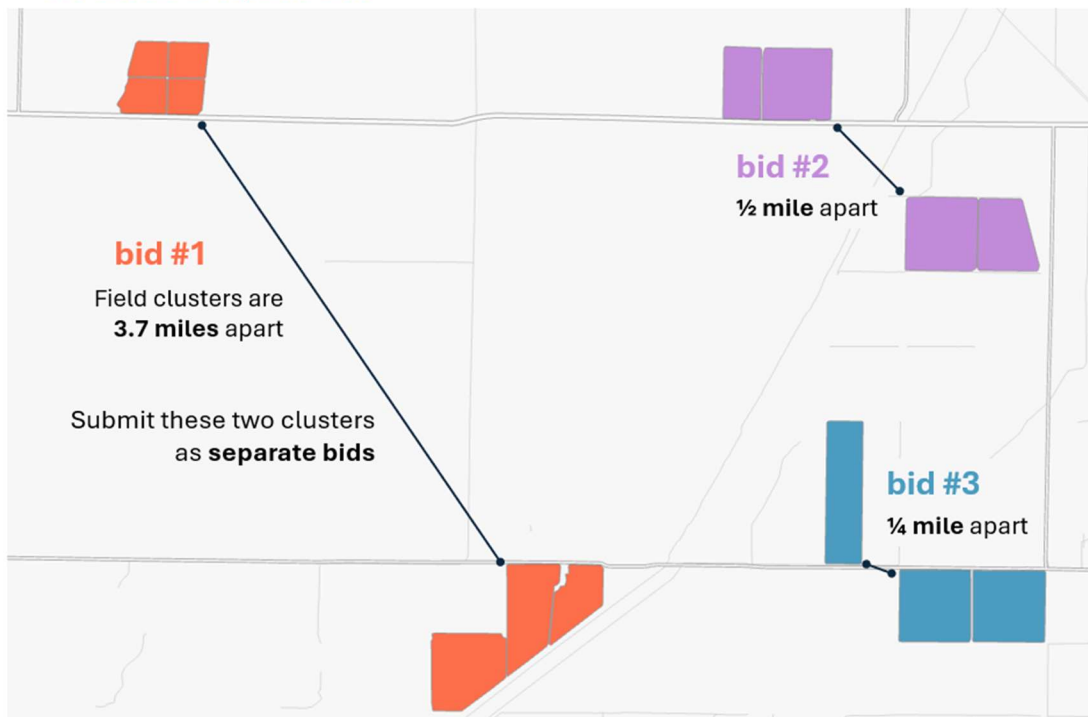


How to **increase your chances** for bid selection

1. A bid should include fields in close proximity... **within one mile** is a good rule of thumb.
2. If fields are available in different locations, you may increase the likelihood of selection is by including nearby fields, ideally fields that are **indivisible from a flooding standpoint** - then create separate bids for fields in different locations.

Bid #1 is **Not Ideal**; fields too far apart (reduces chance of selection). Submit the two clusters as separate bids.

Bids #2 and #3 are **Acceptable**; fields are clustered nearby



Bid #4 is **Ideal**; Fields are clustered in close proximity
